The meeting was called to order at 7:07 pm.

City Clerk, Jeana Hyde, swore in newly elected councilmen Blair Northen and Austin Mitchell.

Councilman Blair Northen asked Councilman Bryan Hale if he would like to be the presiding officer over the meeting. Councilman Bryan Hale declined. Councilman Blair Northen nominated and made the motion to allow himself to be the presiding officer. Councilman Bryan Hale gave the Second and all council present voted 'aye'. The motion passed 4/0.

Motion to approve the Minutes and Councilman Bryan Hale gave the second. All Council present voted 'aye'. The motion passed 4/0.

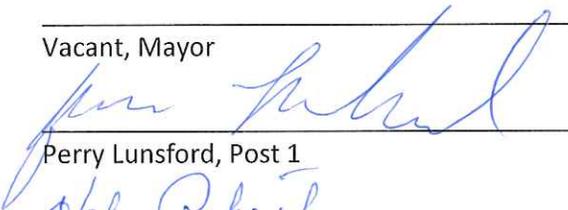
