The honorable Mayor GW Davis Jr called the meeting to order at 11 AM and asked the City Clerk to read the agenda. He then asked for a motion to approve the agenda as read. Councilman Blair Northen made the motion and Councilman Bryan Hale gave the second. All council present voted 'aye'. The motion passed 4/0.

The honorable Mayor also gave the invocation and lead everyone in the pledge.


There were no citizen's comments.

The honorable Mayor GW Davis Jr explained how this meeting come about. He continued to explain that the Town of Newborn's mayor, Gregg Ellwanger, called him requesting to allow Newborn to buy out Mansfield's share of the jointly owned police car. The original purchase price for the police car from the City of Oxford was \$5,000. There was a brief discussion by council on what would be a fair buy out price. After considering the expense of the repairs made to the car and the fact that each city paid equally for repairs, Councilman Austin Mitchell made the motion to request the buy out price to be \$2,500. The honorable mayor pro tempore Perry Lunsford gave the second. All Council present voted 'aye'. The motion passed 4/0.

The honorable mayor pro tempore Perry Lunsford made the motion to waive late fees on the utility bills due April 10 and Councilman Austin Mitchell gave the second. The honorable mayor GW Davis Jr shared that several cities are doing this to help their citizens during this time, when they are unable to work because of the COVID-19 pandemic. He also assured council that the city would continue to work with folks all that we can and that this will be a month to month consideration. All Council present voted 'aye'. The motion passed 4/0.

Councilman Austin Mitchell made the motion to adjourn the meeting and Mayor pro tempore Perry Lunsford gave the second. All council voted 'aye' by hanging up. The motion passed 4/0.

The meeting adjourned at 11:26 AM.



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Perry Lunsford, Post 1, Mayor Pro Tempore






