The honorable Mayor GW Davis Jr lead everyone in The Lord's Prayer and the pledge of allegiance.

The honorable Mayor Pro Tempore Blair Northen made a motion to adopt the agenda as proposed and Councilman Helen Robertson gave the second. All Council present and Councilman Austin Mitchell via telephone voted 'aye'. The motion passed 3/0.

There were no citizen's comments on agenda items.

The honorable Mayor Pro Tempore Blair Northen made the motion that "There is to be no filming in the City of Mansfield unless approved by the City Council on a case by case basis". The mayor and council felt this motion was necessary because of the motion made in the August 12, 2002 Minutes (attached). Both Councilman Helen Robertson and Councilman Austin Mitchell gave seconds. Councilman Helen Robertson explained the purpose of the 2002 motion being made because of a previous film company's unprofessionalism. The honorable Mayor GW Davis Jr expressed concerns on how long the tractor trailers that travel Hwy 11 would have to wait while filming is taking place. Mr. Jason Sargis with SGJK10 LLC said that the NCSO would communicate the need to clear traffic to the film crew but expects it to be no more than 7 – 10 minutes. NC Deputy Smith said the film company's request has no major issues and is within the confines of what the NCSO can do. All Council present and Councilman Austin Mitchell via telephone and Councilman Bryan Hale in written form (attached), voted 'aye'. The motion passed 4/0.

The honorable Mayor GW Davis Jr explained that since Mansfield does not have its own forms and ordinance in place yet, the council will be voting on accepting the Newton County application. The honorable Mayor Pro Tempore Blair Northen made the motion to approve the filming application submitted by SGJK10 LLC to film from 6PM, Friday, October 2, 2020 to 7AM, Saturday, October 3, 2020

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at Rooster's Drive Inn. Councilman Helen Robertson gave the second. Councilman Blair Northen suggested that the City place barricades at Pine St & Highway 11 to avoid any traffic mishaps. Mr. Jason Sargis said the only lights that need to be turned off are the LED lights because they are not period lighting. Mayor GW Davis Jr explained that the light that shines on the mural cannot be turned off unless the wires are cut. Mr. Sargis said they could cover the light. All Council present and Councilman Austin Mitchell via telephone and Councilman Bryan Hale in written form (attached), voted 'aye'. The motion passed 4/0.

V. Business Item c. was struck from the agenda at this time.

The honorable Mayor GW Davis Jr announced the appointment of Mr. Fred Purvis to the Planning Commission. He explained that Mr. Purvis is in favor of living in a small town and believes he will be an asset to the city. No action is needed for this item.

The honorable Mayor GW Davis Jr passed around Mr. Tim Thompson's letter (attached) sharing that if the city accepted Mr. Thompson's offer it would free-up John and Sam's time at the sewer plant in addition to getting quality workmanship. No action is needed for this item at this time.

Mansfield resident, Mr. Jeff Riley, 401 Sewell Rd, commented on the tractor trailers that exit from the alley that runs behind LeMont Vintage Homes onto Hwy 11 turning North hitting the awning at 3121 Hwy 11 and suggested a sign be put up instructing trucks heading South on Hwy 11 to go straight on Pine St to exit and go South on Hwy 11.

Councilman Helen Robertson made the motion to adjourn the meeting and the honorable Mayor Pro Tempore Blair Northen gave the second. All Council present and Councilman Austin Mitchell via telephone voted 'aye'. The motion passed 3/0.



The following items must be submitted with your application for a Newton County Film and Television Production Permit:

- 1. Certificate of insurance coverage for general liability, automotive liability and worker's comp and employer's liability.
- 2. A security plan, if not thoroughly detailed above.
- 3. A check made payable to Newton County Board of Commissioners in the amount of \$50.00 for the general Film and Television Production Permit.
- 4. A check made payable to Newton County Board of Commissioners for any additional fees, if applicable.

Return the completed application and additional required information to the Newton County Board of Commissioners attention Lisa Conner, email localize-newton.ga.us or by mail to 1124 Clark Street, Covington, GA 30014. This application must be received by the County no later than 10 days before filming.

Terms and Conditions

The applicant must agree to all of the terms and conditions set forth in the permit, including without limitation compliance with the following rules:

- The undersigned hereby acknowledges responsibility for adherence to all of the terms and conditions hereof as well as all Federal and State laws and Newton County ordinances.
- The undersigned assumes liability for any and all damages occurring as the result or in connection with the undersigned's use of any Newton County property.
- The undersigned acknowledges that Newton County assumes no liability for any damages, injuries, or expenses incurred as a result of or in connection with the above described event.
- The undersigned certifies that the information contained herein and in the application form is true and correct.
- 5. All applicants must submit a security plan that is approved by the Newton County Sheriff's Office and/or Newton County Fire Services or his/her designee. Based upon the circumstances of the shoot, the applicant may be required to hire off-duty POST-certified police officers as determined and directed by the Newton County Sheriff's Office based solely upon public safety considerations. These officers must have the jurisdictional authority to enforce County ordinances and State law.
- 6. Any and all change requests must be received at least one business day prior to the shoot.
- 7. The applicant must obtain insurance coverage for the shoot.
- 8. If permission is granted by the County, a written permit will be issued including time, date and location of filming and acceptable activities within the scope of the permit.

SUBJECT/PROPOSAL: To expand current contract duties and responsibilities with the primary intention of enhancing water and sewer services, water quality, and overall water reclamation facility maintenance.

Ladies and Gentlemen:

As the sole proprietor of JET Utility Services since 2008, I am responsible for maintaining the city's 5 pump stations (10 pumps total) as well as providing laboratory sample collection and preparing data analysis reports as required by the Environmental Protection Division (EPD). My license as a Water Distribution Systems Operator and Waste Water Operator, as issued by the State of Georgia, allows the City of Mansfield to operate its water delivery and sewer systems. This includes clean water for consumption to all homes and businesses served, the proper handling and disposal of waste water, and the ability to provide an adequate water supply for fire protection and other emergency situations.

Some of you may already be aware that I am taking early retirement from the City of Covington after 38 years of service, effective January 2021. I would like to propose to Mayor Davis and the members of City Council that my duties and responsibilities to Mansfield be expanded in order to improve the overall facility management and maintenance by working on a daily basis to address any important issues that arise, trouble shoot, and implement corrective measures while also performing routine upkeep procedures. By focusing fully on water and sewer services and assuming a more hands-on approach to the plant's daily operations, it is my belief that EPD compliance could improve while also easing the work load currently imposed on other dedicated city employees.

Here are just some of the daily quality control duties and responsibilities for proper plant management:

Ability to make adjustments to chemical feeds.

Check working order of blowers and skimmers.

Adjust sludge returns.

Check for defused air/air leaks.

Clean bar screens and grit chambers.

Monitor clarifiers.

Wash down plant.

Clean traps and wires and contact chambers.

Perform daily lab analysis of samples and accurately record results for reporting to EPD.

Monitor flow.

Grounds upkeep.

Proper treatment for drying of sludge beds.

I would also like to add that I have extensive experience in the field of water and sewer construction which may be of value as situations or projects arise, possibly alleviating the need to hire outside sources or contractors.
