Mayor Northen presented an update for the Enforcement of NO PARKING ordinance. Hwy 213 to Kellogg is NO PARKING. DOT Commissioner has approved it, and Mrs. Lester will be contacting us soon with dates for the NO PARKING signs to be put up. We have spoken with Sheriff Brown and once the signs are placed, they will be enforcing it with warnings for the first 30 days then citations following. The safety of Mansfield Residents is our top concern.

Mayor Northen presented the rezoning of commercial district to mixed use. No action is needed currently. Our attorney asked for more time to prepare for this. Citizen input is appreciated.

New Business:

Mayor Northen presented Newton County Fusus Project, The Cities commitment will be to permit cameras on the city poles of our choosing. They do have recommendations for locations but we don't have to agree to those. Camera will help make Mansfield safer. 1 amp of power will be used per camera. City of Mansfield would have access to those cameras as well. No motion, as request for more details on locations of cameras.
